MY AMAZING DAD

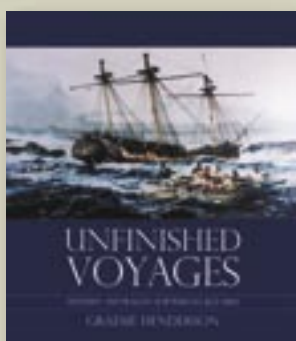
Ross Collins

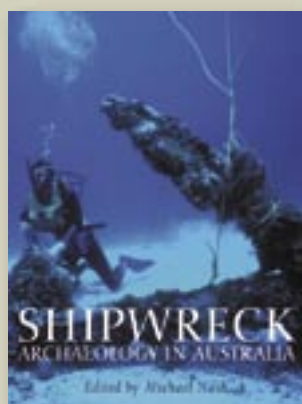


UNFINISHED VOYAGES: WESTERN AUSTRALIAN SHIPWRECKS 1622 - 1850
